

# HERE IS YOUR NEW DUNE BUGGY BEACH CHAIR!

**Please read this instruction paper before using this product & save this page for future reference.**

**NOTE:** Do not use the Dune Buggy for transporting people or pets. Maximum safe load weight is 75 lbs. when used as a carrier.

**NOTE:** While in use, turn **BOTH** control knobs until they “click” into locked position before putting any weight on the hinges.

**DIRECTIONS:** To set the backrest into a reclining position, turn both the outside hinge control knobs to the unlocked position. The teeth of the hinge will disengage when unlocked. Once you have moved the backrest to the desired position, lock it in place by turning both control knobs back to engage the teeth. Please make sure the backrest is locked securely on both sides before leaning back on it. You will hear and feel the control knobs “click” into place when the teeth are properly locked. The maximum recommended sitting weight is 200 lbs.

To use the Dune Buggy as a carrier, place all your gear on the seat and lock the seat back into a vertical position using both control knobs. For safety, please make sure your load is evenly distributed and placed **INSIDE** the control knobs to avoid disengaging the knobs with the weight of the load. The Dune Buggy can carry up to 75 lbs. of outdoor gear when used properly.

**CARE & MAINTENANCE:** The Dune Buggy has been designed with top quality materials and construction. The seat/back fabric is made for years of outdoor use in all weather conditions. The fabric can be cleaned with water and/or mild soap and water as needed. The frame may be cleaned with a mild liquid cleaner to remove scuff marks. Waxing the frame from time to time with liquid or paste wax will maintain its luster and make cleaning easier.

If the control knobs of the hinge mechanism feel too tight (or too loose), adjust them by loosening (or tightening) the nut on the inside cap of the hinge with a 7/16 socket wrench. Do not immerse the Dune Buggy in water. Make sure it is completely dry before storing as the tube can be damaged by frozen water. Store the Dune Buggy indoors during the winter. Clean wheels occasionally by hosing or wiping off any dirt or sand.

**PLEASE NOTE:** The Dune Buggy was not designed to transport people or pets. Damages caused by misuse, unreasonable or abusive use, neglect or damages during shipping are the owner's responsibility. Natural weathering of fabric and finishes is to be expected on this outdoor product.
